### Searching for Your Dream Career

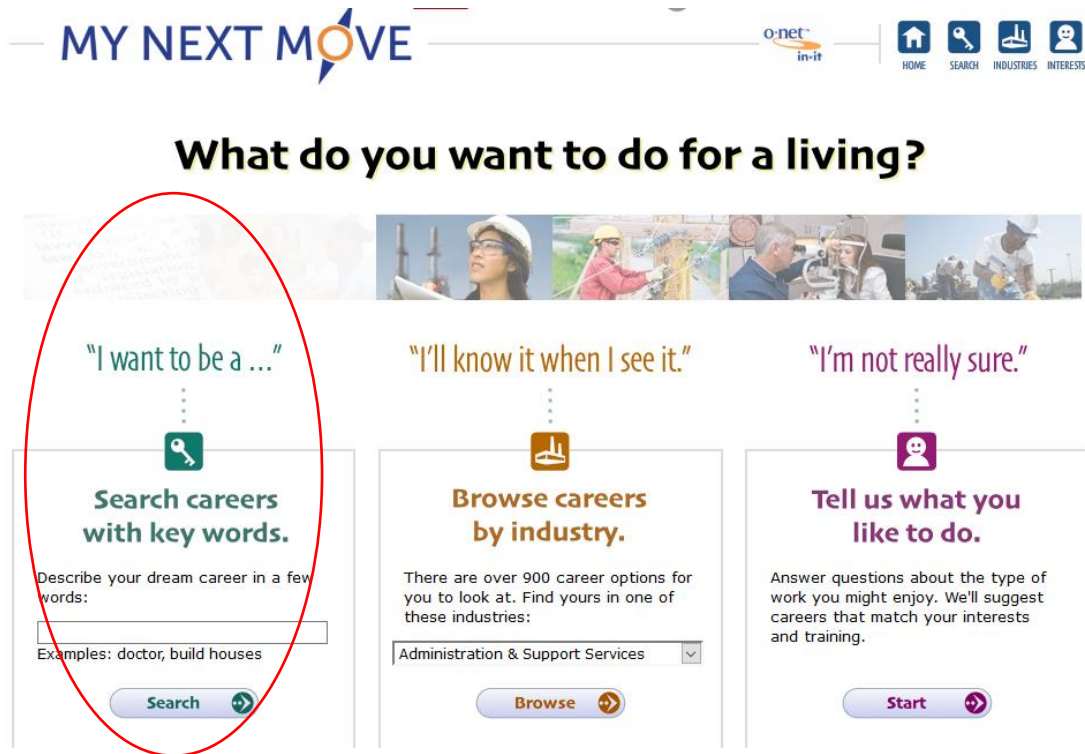

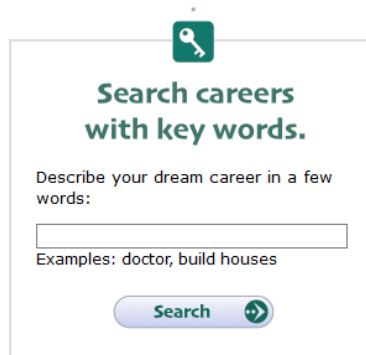


## Tutorial 3

1. Using “ocean diving fish” as the search phrase, the “Search careers” tool generated numerous options to from Fishers to Biologists. Some of the options returned did not relate to the ocean, diving, or fish, but users can still search through these options as well in case they provide a unique and interesting opportunity.

2. Based on the search results, let’s look through “Fishers,” “Commercial Divers,” “Biologists,” and “Coaches & Scouts.”
3. Let’s look first at “Fishers.”



### Fishers & Related Fishing Workers

**Also called:** Captain, Clam Digger, Commercial Fisherman, Deckhand

#### What they do:

Use nets, fishing rods, traps, or other equipment to catch and gather fish or other aquatic animals from rivers, lakes, or oceans, for human consumption or other uses. May haul game onto ship.

#### On the job, you would:

- Steer vessels and operate navigational instruments.
- Put fishing equipment into the water and anchor or tow equipment, according to the fishing method used.
- Maintain engines, fishing gear, and other on-board equipment and perform minor repairs.

4. From here, utilize some of the skills we've learned to identify what this job can give us. From the "Education," this career doesn't require any post-secondary or college degrees or credentials. From "Job Outlook," let's look at the "Local Salary Info."

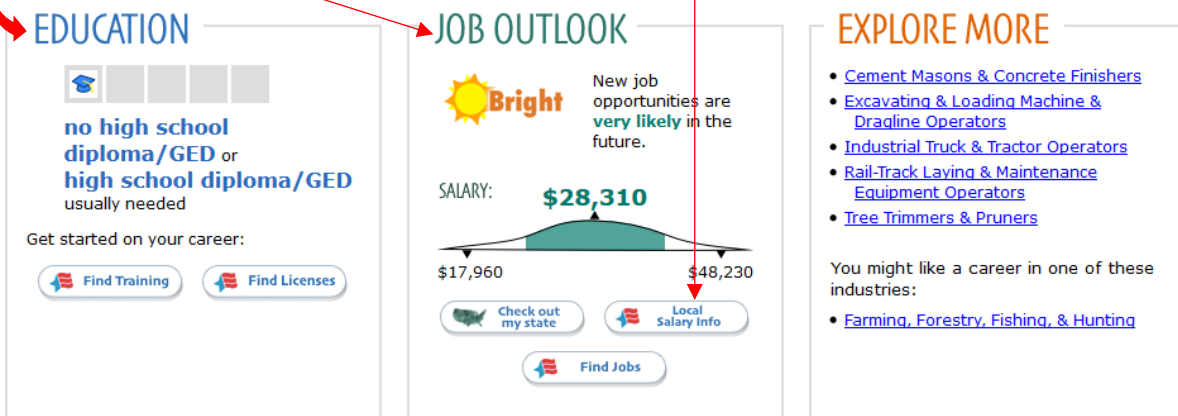

5. From "Salary Info," we'll generally search the state of Florida, since it's known for its beaches and being surrounded by water, and see what we get.

6. In the state of Florida, all of its wage averages for Fishers are above the national average (High: **\$500 above** the average; Median: **\$3,000 above** the average; and Low: **\$8,500 above** the average). This shows that the Fisher career offers a lot to someone seeking to pursue it, if they want to work in Florida

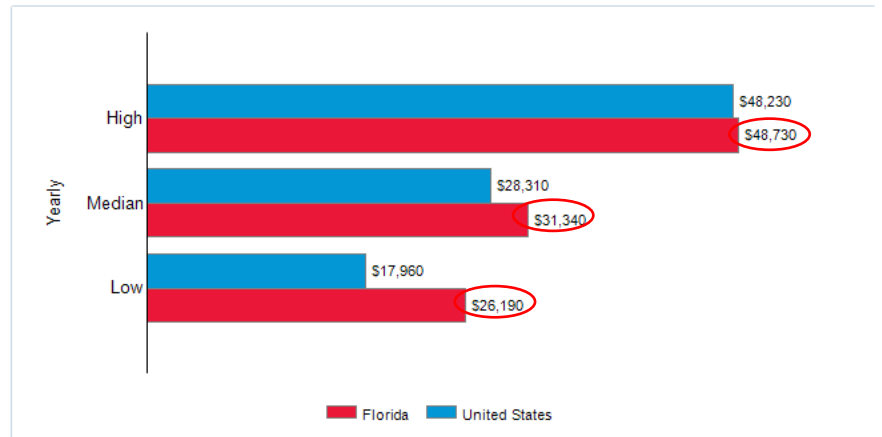

**Also called:** Commercial Diver, Dive Supervisor, Diver, Diver Tender

**What they do:**  
Work below surface of water, using scuba gear to inspect, repair, remove, or install equipment and structures. May use a variety of power and hand tools, such as drills, sledgehammers, torches, and welding equipment. May conduct tests or experiments, rig explosives, or photograph structures or marine life.

**On the job, you would:**

- Take appropriate safety precautions, such as monitoring dive lengths and depths and registering with authorities before diving expeditions begin.
- Check and maintain diving equipment, such as helmets, masks, air tanks, harnesses, or gauges.
- Communicate with workers on the surface while underwater, using signal lines or telephones.





You’ll see that the job is listed as having a “Bright” outlook, but also shows the average annual earnings for the job. Let’s “Check Out the State” to see what the earnings are in the state of Florida, and “Find Jobs” to see if there are any jobs.

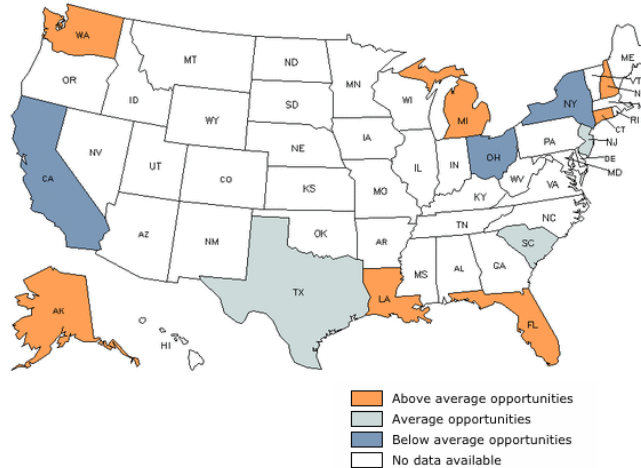

In “Figure 14” the “National Outlook” is bright, stating that “Nationwide, new job opportunities for commercial divers are very likely in the future,” and we can see more states listed as having “Above average opportunities” than “Average or Below average opportunities.” After selecting “Back,” we’ll use the “Find Jobs” tool to look at occupations in Florida.

15. Using “Find Jobs,” we can see that there are only 3 job openings in Florida for this job. We can use the “Find Jobs” tool to search for jobs in other states, maybe in one of the other states with above-average opportunities.

### Tutorial 3

16. Using “Local Salary Info,” find the local average salary for “Commercial Divers” in the state of Florida. We can see in “Figure 19” that on the high end, Commercial Divers in Florida earn \$20,000 above the average, or \$5,000 above the average, for “Low” or “Median” salaries.

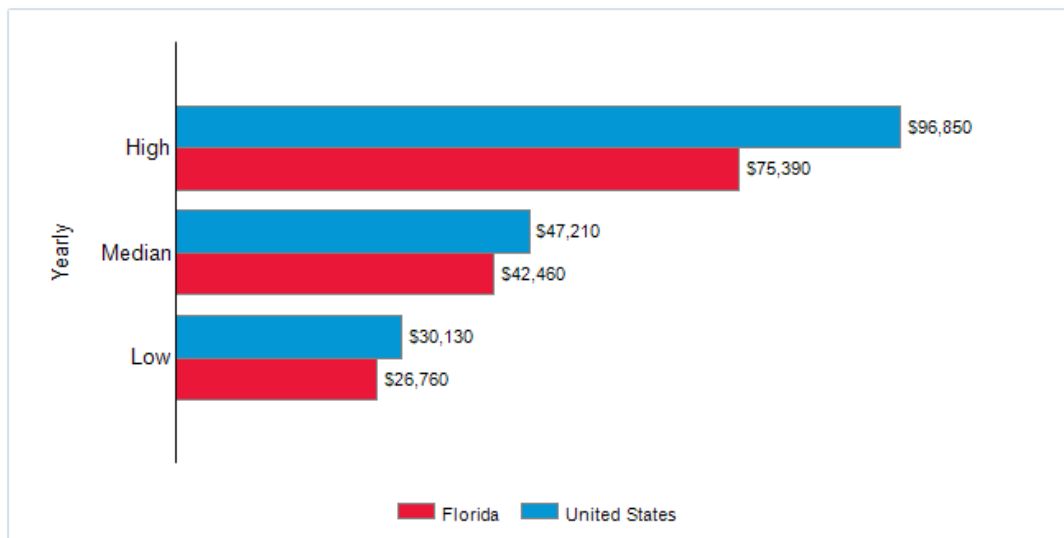
