

2. The "Bright Outlook" page, select the "Bright Outlook" tab, here, to sort the "Bright Outlook" from brightest outlook to dimmest. The charts are broken into careers that "Grow Rapidly" and career "Openings."





3. From here, users can search for occupations based upon the most growth or most openings (this can be used to help plan and prepare to pursue a career, especially for those requiring college or trade training before going into the job market).



5. Users can also return to the homepage and select "Registered Apprenticeship" to reach the same page. Select the "Registered Apprenticeship" tab to sort the careers in order of careers providing apprenticeship opportunities.





6. Using this tool, (refer to Tutorial 1 to see how to use the Registered Apprenticeship tool) users can sort and see what occupations offer apprenticeship opportunities. Remember in Tutorial 1, this tool can connect users to apprenticeship opportunities in their chosen state.










7. The last two tools are the "Interest" assessment and the "Job Prep" tool that operate just as they did in Tutorial 1.



8. First, users can pick from the list of 6 "Interest" options, choosing the interest that best fits the user, or the user can utilize the "O*Net Interest Profiler" to determine which interest best fit the user based upon the user's response to a series of questions. When a user selects an interest, careers will be presented that fit that interest profile. We'll use "Realistic."

- 10. Users can also return to the "Job Prep" tool to find careers based on the amount of "Job Preparation" or training required to pursue a particular career.

11. Selecting one of the 5 "Job Zones," users can find a listing of jobs that require whatever degree of preparation and training interests them, from "1" that requires the least to "5" that requires the most preparation, education, or training.
